Graduation Requirements

Complete 12 credit hours.

Certificate must be completed within 5 years.

Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 .

Only courses in which a student receives a **B - or better** will count toward a degree or certificate in the Robertson School of Government.

Notes

¹ All certificate students must take these co-requisites their first semester of matriculation.

Students may not use coursework to receive both a certificate and an academic concentration in overlapping or similar fields.

MA in Government, MA in National Security Studies, and MPA students have the option of earning multiple certificates.

Non-degree seeking students may earn one certificate without being admitted to the MA in Government, MA in National Security Studies, or MPA programs.
