- $_{\rm 2}$ One course may be taken in a complementary area within the School of Divinity or in another graduate school within Regent University and counted within the concentration.
- $_3$ Students must seek formal approval for their supervised ministry experience through the School of Divinity's Director of Field Education.
- * Note: Students wishing to gain additional practical experience during the course of their program may also wish to enroll in a Practicum (PMIN 580; ICSD 580) or an additional internship (PMIN 595) either of which can be taken in addition to SFRM 502 as one of their concentration courses.
