¹Students are registered for UNIV 500 based on their admissions writing sample score. Students are required to take UNIV LIB and ENGL 500 but both courses are waived if a student successfully completes UNIV 500.

²Recommended to take during first or second semester.

³Approval required from Academic Advisor.
